

Pewee Valley Cemetery

The Pewee Valley Cemetery was established in May 1871. In 1904 the Directors of the cemetery authorized the subdivision of the cemetery into three sections, one for the black and one for the white populations of Pewee Valley and the surrounding areas and one for the State of Kentucky to use for the interments of veterans from the Confederate Veterans Home located in Pewee Valley. The black section, identified as Section B in this survey, is located on the north side of Maple Avenue, white and Confederate sections are located on the south side of Maple Avenue and are identified in this survey as Section A and Confederate, respectively. The cemetery is located on Maple Avenue in Pewee Valley, Oldham County, Kentucky.
