

Floydsburg Cemetery

The cemetery originally started with 3/4 acre donated by William Boulware in 1799. Another acre of land was donated 19 years later by Mr. Boulware. There is a bronze plaque which denotes the site of the Floydsburg Methodist Church 1818-1909, and also a bronze plaque marking the site of the Floydsburg School in the cemetery. A Cemetery Charter was issued by the State of Kentucky to Floydsburg Cemetery Company on Feb 19, 1894. Duncan Memorial Chapel stands near the entrance of the cemetery. Location is on Hwy 1408 in Floydsburg, 1-2 miles south of Crestwood. 1816 was earliest burial found.
